Nonviolent Peaceforce (NP) envisions a worldwide culture of peace where conflicts within and between communities and nations are managed through nonviolent means. NP is a global civil society organisation that works with people affected by violent conflicts to enhance their security and dignity through unarmed civilian protection (UCP) and by helping to transform the world's response to conflict situations.

Nonviolent Peaceforce has established a programmatic presence in Iraq since 2017 to protect civilians and prevent violence. We are looking for an enthusiastic and dynamic Programme Development Officer who will be responsible for managing key compliance and monitoring and evaluation activities to include, but not limited to, donor compliance, grant management, contract negotiation, and proposal writing to aid in the development of NP's area of operations. Frequent travel to Federal Iraq (Ninewa) is required.

The successful candidate is a motivated leader with proven skills in implementing, monitoring and evaluating projects in the humanitarian sector. S/he has excellent organization and management skills to accurately complete multiple tasks by establishing priorities in a sometimes difficult and challenging environment. S/he has demonstrated experience negotiating contracts with donors and managing grant programs, including compliance monitoring. S/he is a collaborative team player with the ability to connect and build trust with people in a multicultural environment. S/he has an excellent command of English, both oral and written. Thematic experience in civilian protection, human security, violence reduction and/or peacebuilding is an asset.
