Nonviolent Peaceforce (NP) is a dynamic, international non-governmental organization. NP works to reduce violence and protect civilians in countries affected by violent conflict and its aftermath. NP implements unarmed civilian protection programming with thematic focus on child protection, women's participation in peace and security, prevention and protection from sexual and gender based violence, protection in displacement settings, inter/intra communal violence reduction, to support local protection and peace infrastructure and in support of cease fires and peace processes.

NP is seeking a dynamic, committed, and energetic new colleague to fill the role of Global Director of Programmes.

The ideal candidate is someone with a passion and proven skillset for supporting quality field programs. S/he will have strong field experience in conflict and complex emergency settings, including as a Country Director, Regional Director, or equivalent level and will be committed to a field-focused approach to implementation. While providing support to NP's Heads of Missions in our current operational areas, s/he will lead the opening of new country programmes and the development of the appropriate global systems to enable NP to continue to grow.

The post-holder will be a member of the global Senior Management Team and will serve as one of two deputies for the Executive Director.
