

# **STREAM PROJECT**

#### Strengthening youth engagement and action towards peace in Mindanao

The conflicts in Mindanao are more than a half-century struggle that brought severe, wide-ranging, and long-lasting impact to young people in the southern part of the Philippines. To contribute in responding to the situation of youth in rural and conflicted-affected areas in BARMM and Northern Mindanao, the project "Youth for a Culture of Peace and Non-Violence in Mindanao" (YOUCAP) supports

Nonviolent Peaceforce in its **STREAM Project**, aimed at strengthening youth capacity and participation in local peace and security initiatives.

YOUCAP is a project of "Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit" (GIZ) commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).

The STREAM project is specifically being implemented in 3 municipalities, 2 in Maguindanao and 1 in Bukidnon, with United Youth of the Philippines-Women Inc. (UnYPhil-Women) and United Women of Matigsalug, Manobo, and Kulamanen Tribes (KMMKM) as local partners.
