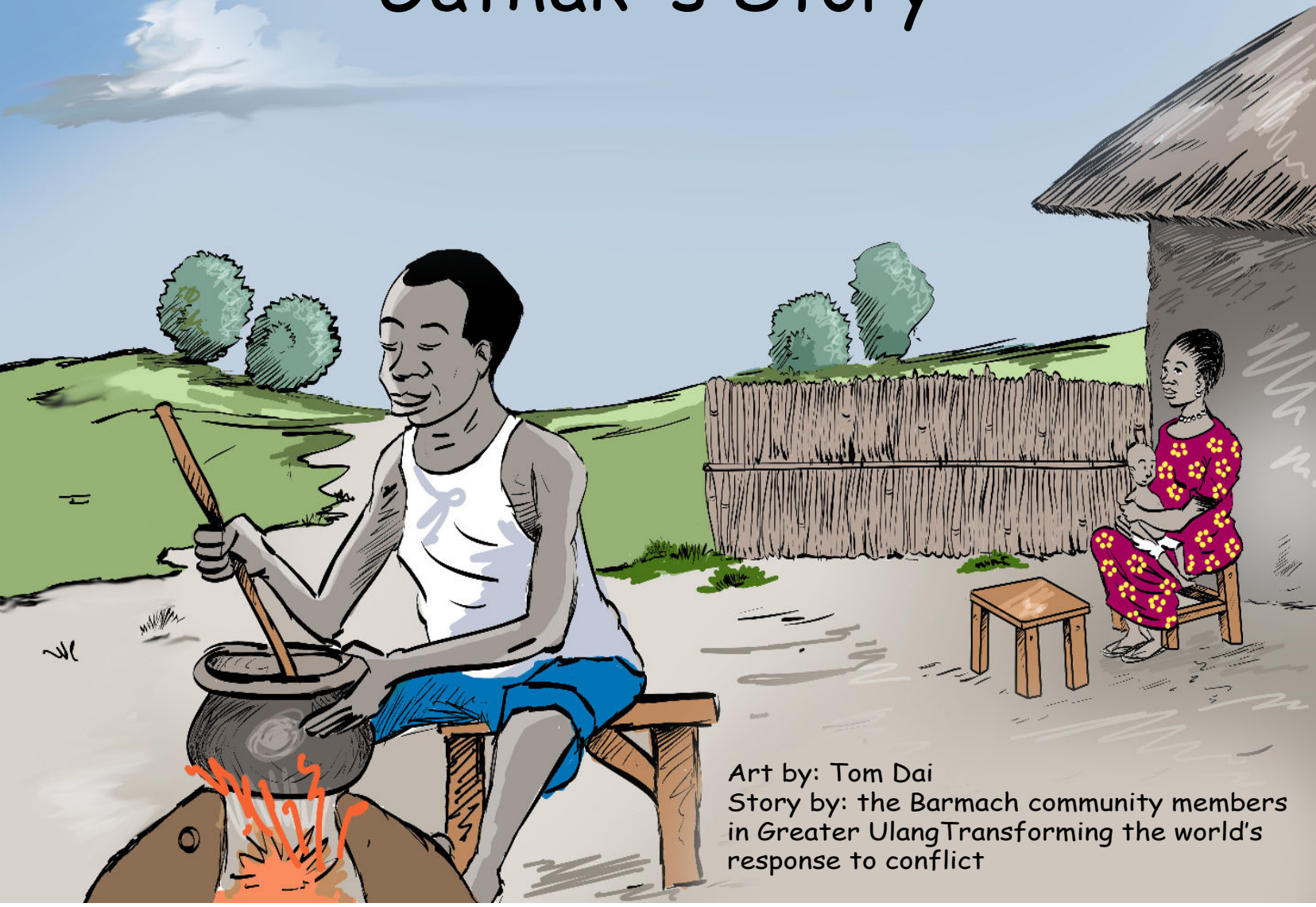


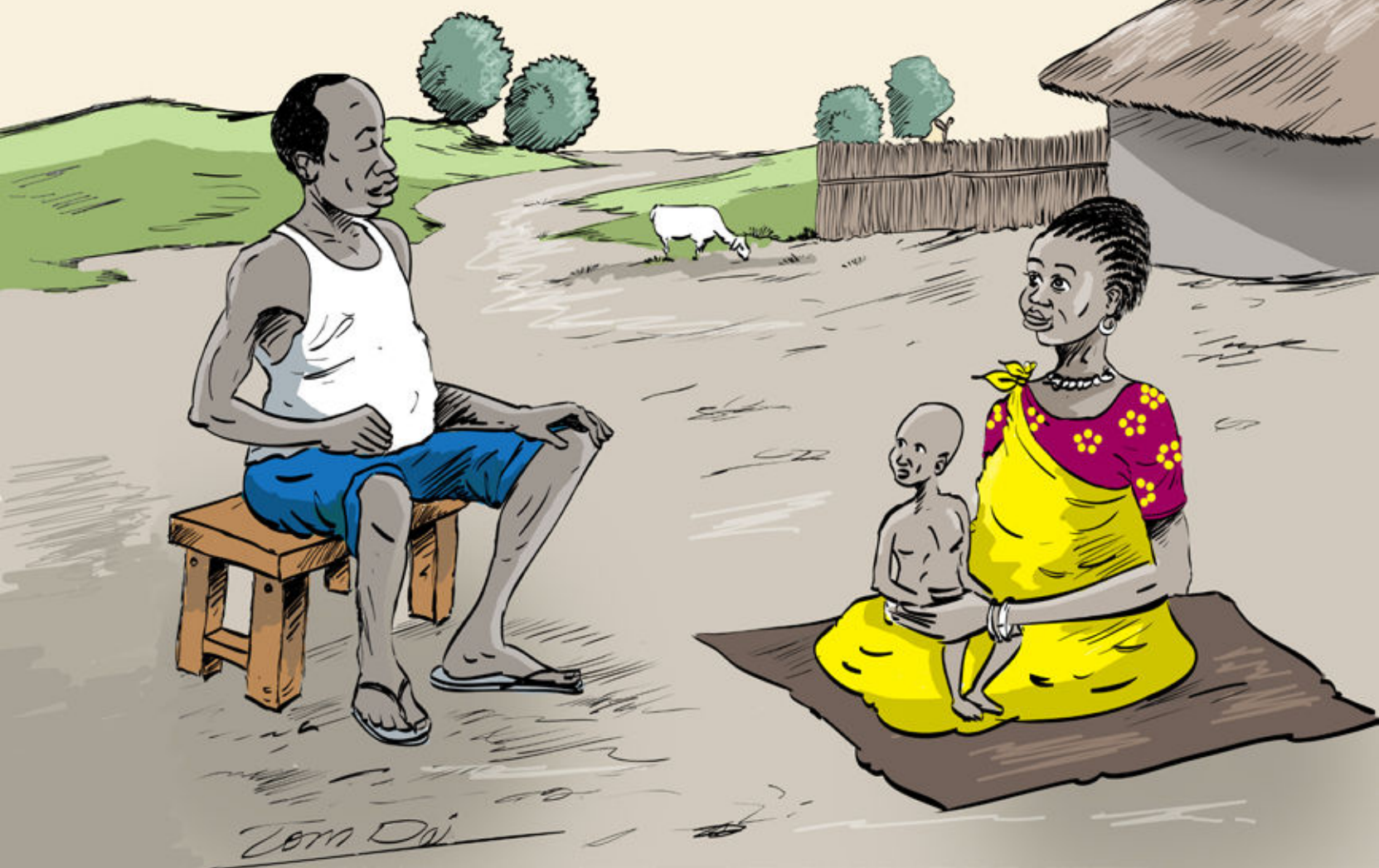

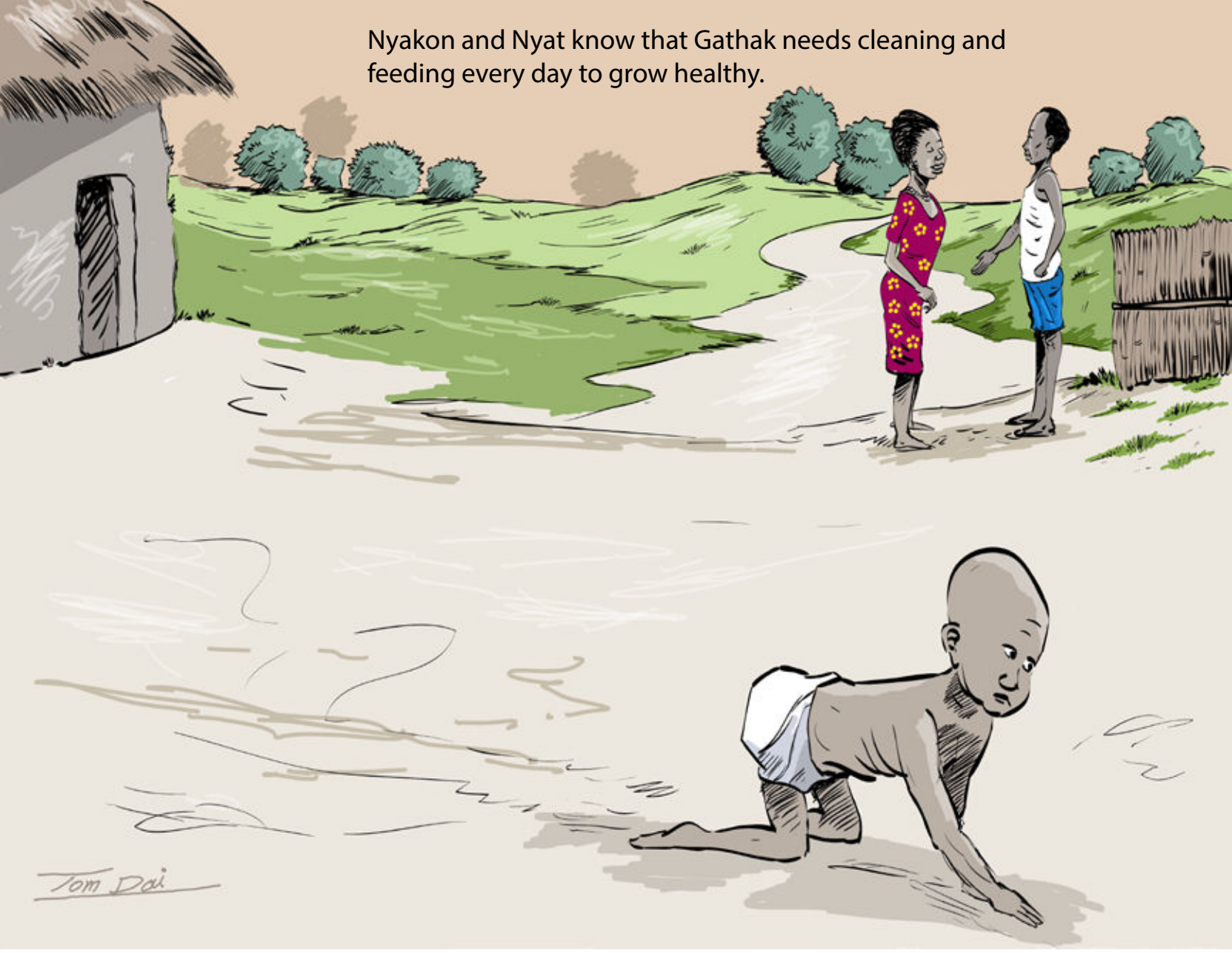

Before Gathak goes to sleep, his father sings lullabies for him and then Gathak has a nice, deep, and peaceful sleep.



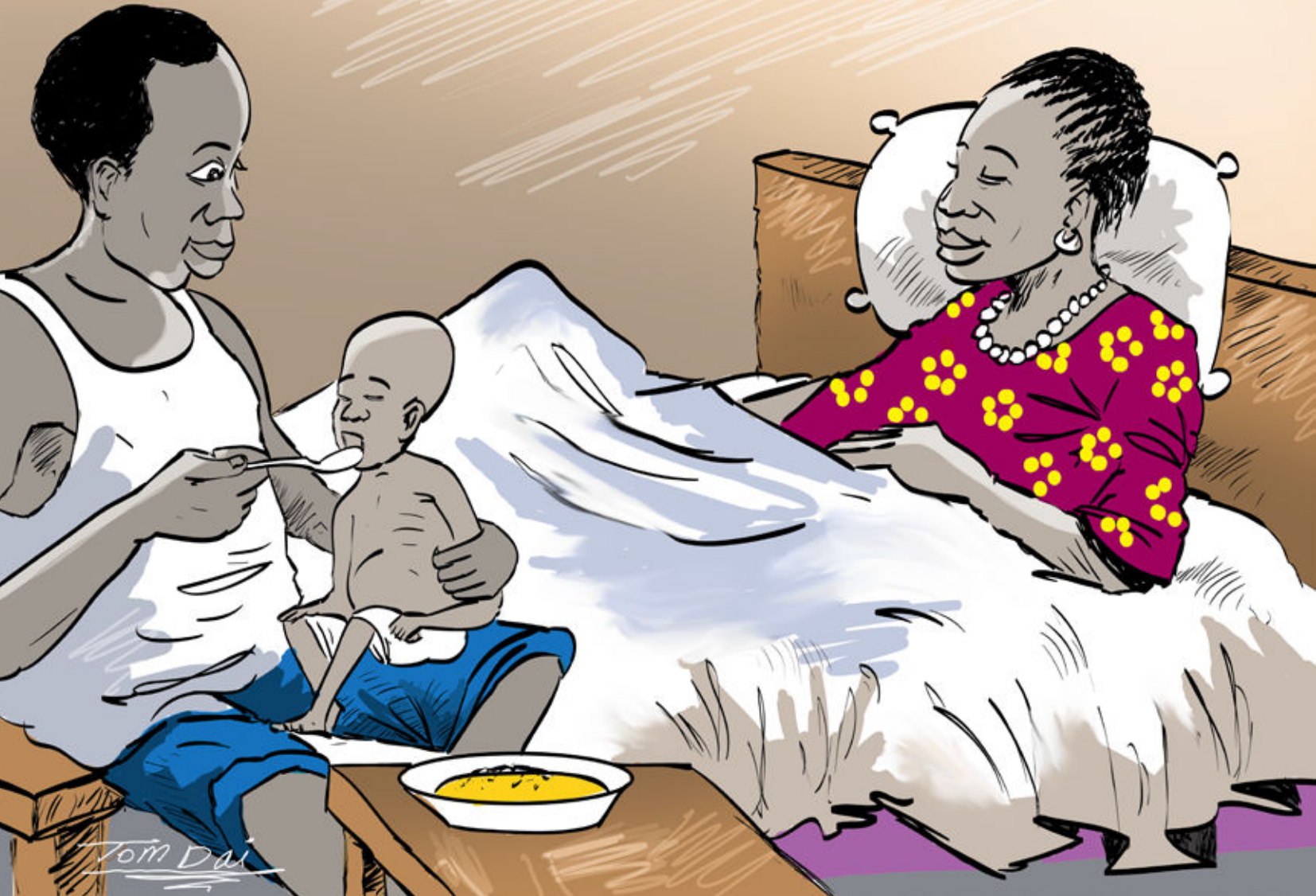


One day, Gathak's mother was sick.

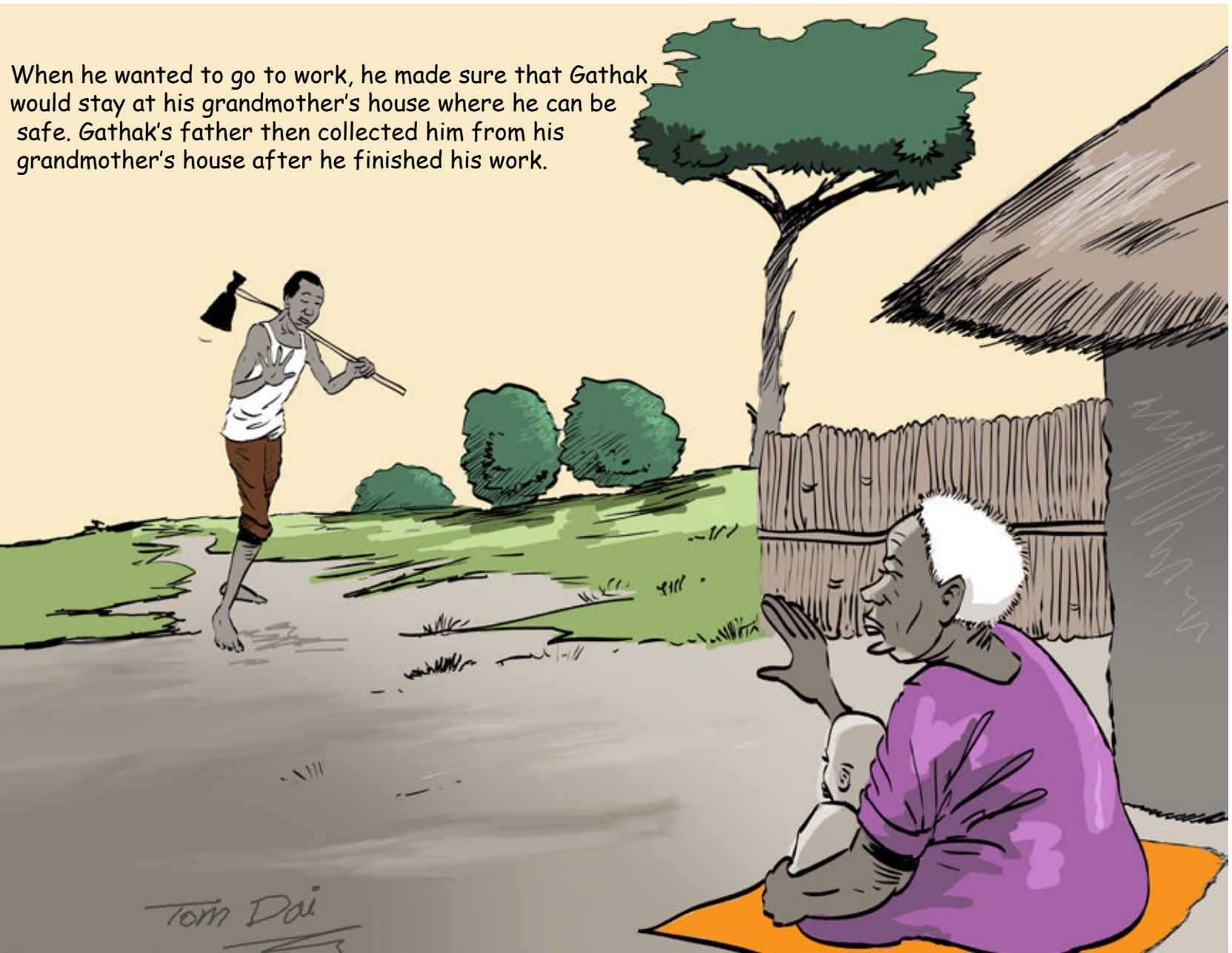
So Gathak's father was thinking about how to help his wife get more rest.



He then asked his wife to rest. He prepared Gathak's food and made soup for his wife.

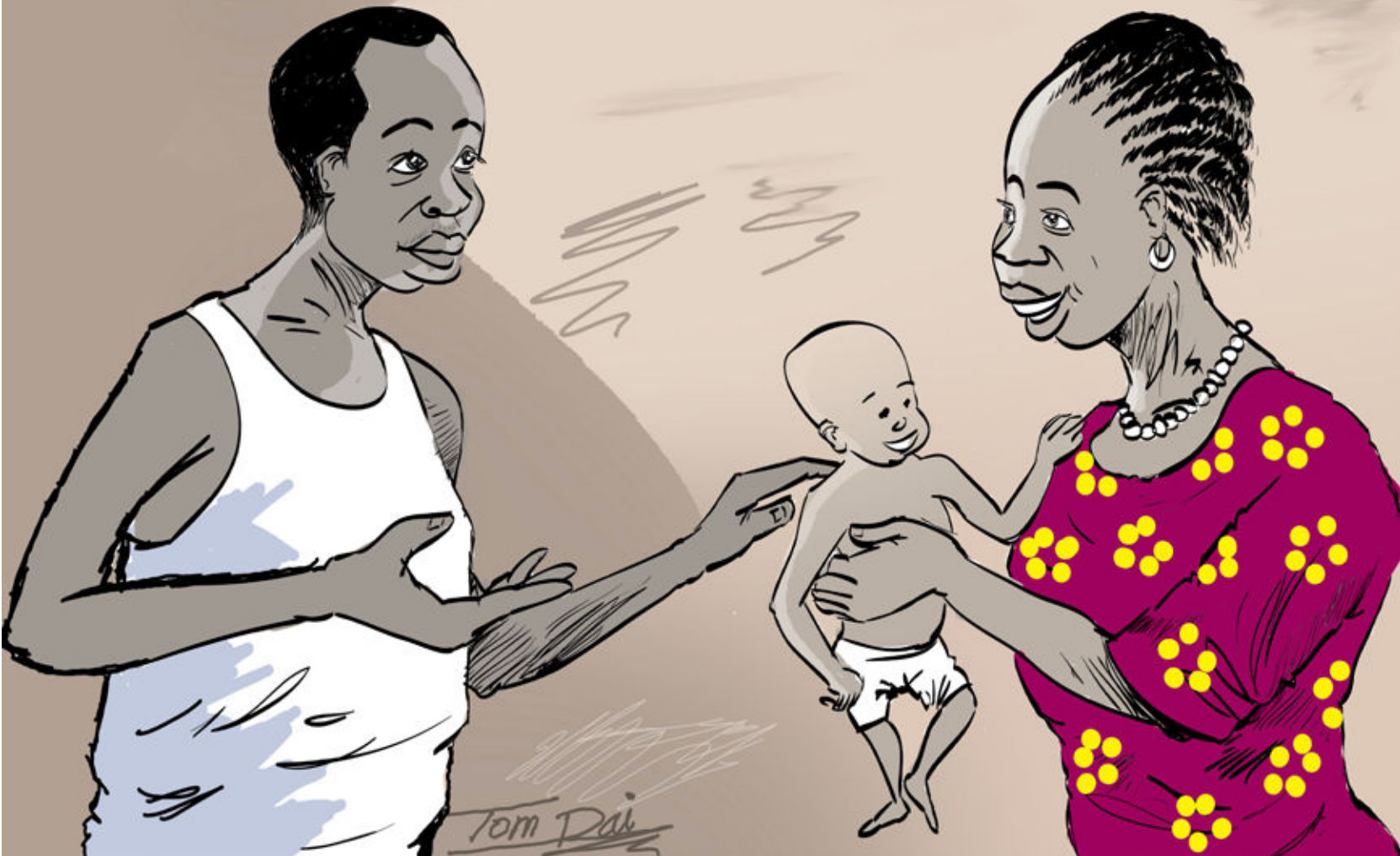
