

The need of MILF-dominated Bangsamoro interim authority for technical support in governance

Double efforts to deliver socioeconomic services

Ongoing, recurring, and unresolved rido conflicts in Moro-dominated areas

Safety risks of civilian communities against armed groups outside the peace process e.g. BIFF, Maute Group

Concerns in the decommissioning and community reintegration of MILF combatants



Bangsamoro transition and normalisation

Limited community education and sensitisation about the transition and normalisation

Challenges in addressing the prevalence of small arms and light weapons (SALW) and disbanding private armed groups (PAGs)

Unclear role of local government units (LGUs) in the normalisation process.


